Year 6 Transition Events Tuesday 5th July 10.00-12.00 Thursday 7th July 9.30-14.30 and 16.00-19.00

To support your son/daughter in their transition to secondary education we have organised an additional event to our main transition day and evening. On **Tuesday 5th July (10am-12pm)** we welcome your son/daughter into School to meet other students from our non-feeder schools. We appreciate that some may be the only one joining us from their primary school, this event provides an opportunity to meet others in a similar position and become more confident in their surroundings ahead of the main event on Thursday.

Please arrive from 9.50am, wearing full school uniform. Please bring a water bottle with you a snack will be provided, free of charge. Attendance is optional, if you wish to attend the event please use the Google form to book your place;

We then look forward to inviting your son/daughter into our school for their transition day on **Thursday 7th July**, please arrange for them to be dropped off in reception from 9.20am and collect at 2.30pm. We expect students to wear their full school uniform and bring a water bottle, break and lunches will be provided from our school canteen free of charge.

In the afternoon;

- The school site is open to parents from 2.30pm to purchase PE kit from our suppliers Birds of Dereham.
- From 4pm, meetings with your son/daughter's tutor can be booked using the School Cloud platform. The meetings will be held in person, but booking them should allow you to plan out your evening. Please also use the platform to book an appointment with, Mrs Chappell, our trust assistant SENCO.
- Refreshments will be available throughout the evening and we have welcomed back some of our Year 7 students to meet our next cohort and answer any questions they may have.
- At 6.40pm we invite you to the sports hall, to meet the senior leadership team and review their first day at St Clement's High School.

If you have anything you would specially like to discuss or raise, we would encourage you to leave a message to their teacher ahead of the evening.

9am and close ahead on Tuesday 5th July, so please do book your appointment before the day. Appointments with each tutor will be 5 minutes long, to allow everyone to be seen. Mrs Cawston (KS3 Pastoral Support Officer) and myself will be available for drop-in appointments on the evening.
