



Introduction of Spanish Lessons

Later this year our Year 9 students will be selecting the subjects they will study in Year 10. Government guidance now expects 95% of students in this year group to continue studying a Modern Foreign Language at GCSE level. In order to expand the choice available to students we are adding the option of Spanish to our current offering of French.
