Positive Covid-19 result in school

I am writing to inform you that I have today been informed that one of our Year 8 students has tested positive for Covid-19.

As required we have contacted the families of all students who sat near this student 48 hours prior to him developing symptoms. Those students have been asked to isolate for ten days since the last contact which means isolation will continue up to and including Sunday 27th December 2020. I would like to thank everyone for the supportive manner in which these telephone calls were received, it was clear that the overwhelming response to this difficult news was concern for the student involved.
