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
Revision Tips

- 1. Start early- give yourself the most time possible to revise.
- 2. Plan your revision- use the revision timetable below.
- Get the basics right- make sure you are eating healthily, drinking plenty of water, exercising and getting a good night's sleep
- 4. **Remove distractions-** place your phone in a draw or another room.
- 5. **Short sessions-** keep sessions to 25 minutes, followed by 5 minute breaks.
- 6. **Break topics down** into bite-size chunks.
- 7. **Repetition-** the more times you revise a topic, the more likely you are to remember it.

Revision Techniques

Flash cards & Spaced learning

- 1. Use your notes or your textbook to identify key concepts in the material. On one side of a flashcard, write the keyword. On the back of the flashcard, write the definition.
- 2. Complete retrieval practice by reading the key word on one side, and trying to recall the definition.
