Contingency day notice – summer 2026

The Contingency day for GCSE examinations is the 24th of June this date is set aside by exam boards for use if national or local disruptions arise during the GCSE summer exams. Students need to be aware that they must be available on this date and if parents or carers are booking holidays they should do so after the 24th of June.

Appeals against centre assessed (non-exam assessment) marks

All students have the right to appeal their non-exam assessment marks before they are uploaded to awarding body websites.

Appeals must be made in writing, to the exams officer, no later than one week after marks have been received from subject teachers.

Students may request copies of their marked assessments and mark schemes/assessment criteria to help decide if they would like to proceed with an appeal.

Students will be informed of the outcome of their appeal in writing.
