

Summer School 2021

St Clement's High School offered all students in their Year 7 cohort of 2021 a place at Summer School, the weeks attendance was expected, but there were some students who were only able to attend on some days. We had an overwhelming number of students attending (80% of cohort). Students completed a range of activities such as;

The theme of the week was BE FIRST and students were given lots of opportunities for the first time, alongside their lessons we also had a range of guest speakers in and completed our first community drive – a collection for a local Hedgehog rescue company.
