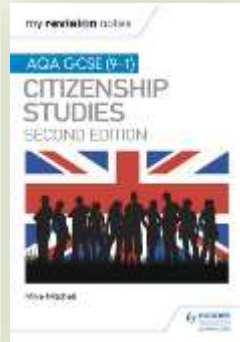

Top tips for Citizenship:

- Keep looking over and revising your Action Investigation Portfolio, make sure it is complete so you can look over it frequently to remember what you did, and prepare for questions on the paper.
- Re-write your notes to keep them fresh; try highlighting or colour coding to help with understanding.
- Create key word flash cards with the key word on one side and the definition on the other. – key words will help you to read, understand, and answer questions much more effectively!
