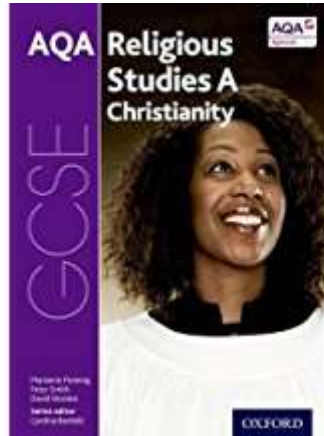


# Religious Studies

There are Christianity revision guides available from the library. There is no Hinduism revision guide so you will need to make sure your Hinduism exercise books are complete so you can use those for revision purposes.



The AQA website has a copy of the specification for the Religious Studies A course. We are studying: Christianity beliefs and practices, Hinduism beliefs and practices, and Religion, philosophy and ethics in the modern world from a Christian perspective. There are also some sample GCSE papers on that website, with mark schemes.

You must learn the key words and definitions for all of the topics we have studied.

You must make an effort to read through and learn some quotes from sacred texts.



You must practice the different types of questions.

A 5 mark question needs to include two points and a reference/quote from a religious text. Each point/paragraph needs to link clearly back to the questions.

A 12 mark question needs to include four paragraphs. Start with an introduction explaining the key word in the question. Then write a paragraph explaining why some religious people would agree with the statement. Then write a paragraph explaining why some religious people would disagree with the statement. Finish with a conclusion explaining what you think based on your knowledge of religious beliefs and practices.
