Wild Japan (U) – Despite a sprawling human population, heavy industry and natural challenges such as earthquakes and tsunamis, Japan retains many ecological treasures (2015)

Cowspiracy (ALL) – Learn how factory farming is decimating the planet's natural resources – and why this crisis has been largely ignored by major environmental groups (2014)

Islands of the Future (ALL) – Amid rising oil & gas prices and dwindling resources, tiny islands off the coast of Europe are rethinking the future of energy (2014)

Happy Feet Two (U) – Mumble the tap-dancing penguin returns in the sequels to the animated musical. This time, Mumble's son, Erik, is struggling to groove (2011)

A Turtle's Tale (U) Sammy, a sea turtle, leaves the beach and spends the next 50 years exploring the world's oceans, all while trying to find his first love (2010)

Bee Movie (U) Barry, a worker bee stuck in a dead-end job making honey, sues humans when he learns they've been stealing bees' nectar all along (2007)
