The uniform will be delivered to the school free of charge for you to collect before the term starts in September on the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> Monday of each month. However, we do recommend where possible, to order to your home address for a small delivery charge (£3.95), as Price and Buckland are offering free returns within 14 days, if the items are not correct.
