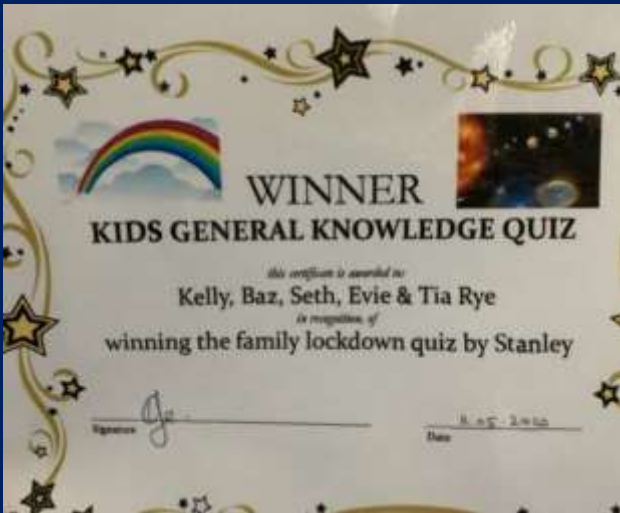
Ben T

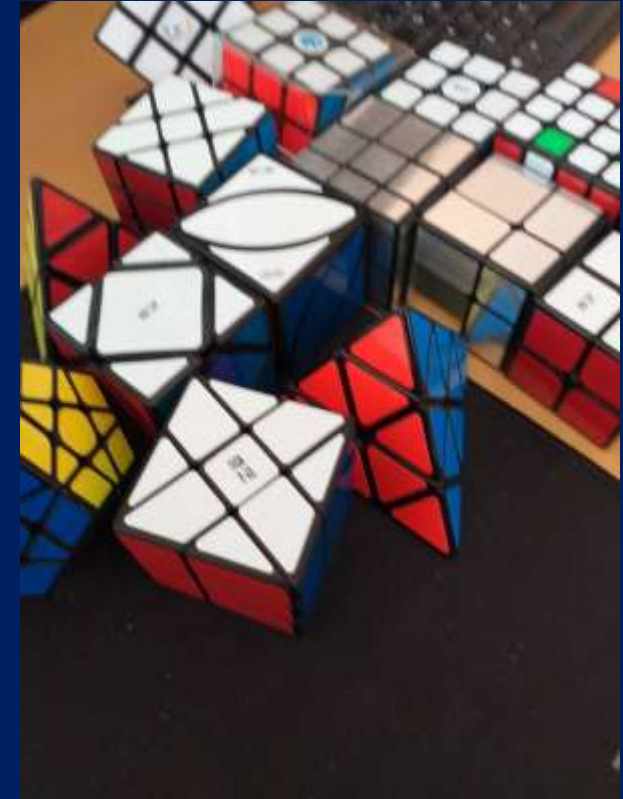

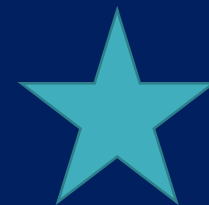
