Year 9 Bi-Annual Assessment

Our second Year 9 assessment fortnight begins on Monday 17th May, individual teachers will set revision activities and/or list topics for students to revise on Satchel One and Google Classroom. An examination timetable of the fortnight can be found [here](#).

If an assessment is missed due to absence, staff will make allowance for it to be caught up at their convenience, but where possible the next lesson. These assessments are important as it will be the last curriculum assessment before the students enter Key Stage Four, for some it will be the last formal assessment in subjects they have chosen not to study further. In class assessments and end of topic assessments are still calendared until the end of the year, but this is the last whole curriculum focused assessment in Key Stage Three for this year group.
