Year 7 Virtual Tutor Appointment Request

Thursday 10th June – 4.30-7pm

I would like to invite you to attend a Year 7 Virtual Tutor appointment, you will have the opportunity to discuss academic progress and be provided with key guidance in preparation for their Assessment fortnight later in the year. The evening will be hosted via an online platform, the link for which can be found at;

To book an appointment you will need to click on the event shown then click any of the green cells to make an appointment. To change an appointment, delete the original by hovering over the blue box and click *Delete* then choose an alternate time. Alternatively you can instruct the software to create the appointments for you based on yours and their tutor's availability. If you have anything you would specially like to discuss or raise, we would encourage you to leave a message to their teacher ahead of the evening.

Year 7 Assessment Fortnight will begin on Monday 28th June, students will be assessed across the curriculum in each subject, examining the content they have learnt and skills they have developed this year. This evening is a good opportunity for you to understand what it entails and how the tutor team will be supporting your son/daughter in School.

Further instructions and guidance of using this system are published on our School website, under the subheading 'Parents'. Bookings will close ahead of Tuesday 8th June, so please do book your appointment before the day. Appointments with each tutor will be 5 minutes long, and will automatically cut out after the designated time. Unfortunately, we are unable to extend appointment times; however if further discussions are required you are advised to make an appointment through the school reception. There is additional staff members available on the evening for you to book an appointment with, Mrs Chappell (Trust Assistant SENCO), Mrs Cawston (KS3 Pastoral Support Officer) and myself. There is no obligation to book these additional appointments, but the option is there for you if you wish.

We very much look forward to seeing you with your child and believe the evening will prove to be both useful and successful for all involved. We will contact you after the event to allow you the opportunity to provide feedback.
