Dear Parents/Carers,

All schools are required to provide a remote education for students who need to isolate due to the Coronavirus. Recent legislation has reduced the potential number of students who need to isolate, as children are no longer required to isolate if they have close contact with a Covid positive person. However, all students need to have access and be aware of the procedures, in case they do need to isolate.

At St Clement's High School, all students have been invited to Google Classrooms with their individual class teachers. Work will be uploaded to these classrooms for students who are isolating with instructions from their class teachers about how to submit their work.

To assist you in supporting your child/children's learning, we will be sending you the option to connect to their Google Classroom account, allowing you to see the work that is being set, when it is due and if the work has been submitted.

You will shortly receive an email from school with your invite, to the email address you have provided through your data collection data collection booklets. Please check your SPAM folder before contacting the school, in case your provider automatically assigns it to this folder.

When you receive this email you will be invited to set up a free Google account (if that is not your personal provider). This is not needed, but it does work slightly better with a Google account as it allows you to change the summary report from weekly to daily, providing further insights.

As a guardian to your child/children's assigned Google Classrooms you will receive a summary report. You can review:

- Missing work—Work not turned in when the summary was sent.
- Upcoming work—Work that's due today and tomorrow (for daily emails) or that's due in the upcoming week (for weekly emails).
- Class activities—Announcements, assignments, and questions recently posted by teachers.
