Year 7 Bi-Annual Assessment Fortnight

Having just welcomed our year 7 students back after Half term we are entering into the first of the two year 7 assessment fortnights. This assessment period will begin on Wednesday 23rd February, individual teachers will have set revision activities and/or list topics for students to revise on Satchel One and Google Classroom. These assessments will assess the students on the content taught and skills gained in Year 7. Whilst in class assessments and end of topic assessments are still calendared throughout the year, this is an opportunity to prepare students for an intensive examination period.

If an assessment is missed due to absence, staff will ensure the assessment is caught up, where possible the next lesson. Further to the work set by class teachers, tutors will support in school developing revision techniques with students. Mrs Cawston, our Y7 pastoral support officer, will also be providing additional support for the students during this period.
