I would like to make you aware of the new opportunities for instrumental lessons that are available at St Clement's.

Learning a musical instrument can be the start of a fantastic journey that may lead to a career, or just become a hobby that can continue to be enjoyed through education and later life. Many colleges and employers also recognise the skills that learning an instrument has built up.

As part of the West Norfolk Academies Trust, we are very pleased to be able to offer subsidised lessons for our students, as well as being able to loan some instruments for the first part of this journey.

Students who qualify for Pupil Premium are able to apply separately for funding. Please contact Mrs Cawston at the school for details.

### Music lesson subsidies at St Clement's

Please see the table attached for the subsidy available. These will change as the student moves through the school, and are offered if the student is learning as part of a group.

Students learning an **orchestral** instrument will have free loan of the instrument through Year 7 and Year 8, or until they reach Grade 3 standard.

Students learning a **non orchestral** instrument could have free loan of an acoustic guitar or bass guitar in Year 7.

Students learning an **endangered** instrument will have free loan of the instrument throughout the time they are receiving the lessons.

If a student would like **individual** lessons, the cost would be £16 per 30 minute lesson. Of course, these are still available for any student who would prefer to learn in this way. The cost per term would be £160 (10 lessons).
