



The Diana Award Anti-Bullying Ambassador Training

Dear Parent/carer,

Your child has been nominated by their form tutor as someone who would make an outstanding ambassador for anti-bullying. For them to complete this role, we would like them to attend training on Wednesday 30th November at Springwood High School 9am – 3.30pm. We will provide transport to and from the event but do ask that you make arrangements for them to be dropped off at school at 8.30am and collected at the end of the school day, we will arrive back at St Clement's High School by 4.15pm.

Students will need to bring a packed lunch on the day as lunch will not be provided, we will organise in school a packed lunch if they are eligible for free school meals. We expect all students to wear their full school uniform and bring their own pens and pencils. Throughout the day students will be working alongside other students across the region following the itinerary shown below:
