



The Diana Award Anti-Bullying Ambassador Training

Dear Parent/carer,

Your child has been nominated by their form tutor as someone who would make an outstanding ambassador for anti-bullying. For them to complete this role, we would like them to attend training on Wednesday 30th November at Springwood High School 9am – 3.30pm. We will provide transport to and from the event but do ask that you make arrangements for them to be dropped off at school at 8.30am and collected at the end of the school day, we will arrive back at St Clement's High School by 4.15pm.

Students will need to bring a packed lunch on the day as lunch will not be provided, we will organise in school a packed lunch if they are eligible for free school meals. We expect all students to wear their full school uniform and bring their own pens and pencils. Throughout the day students will be working alongside other students across the region following the itinerary shown below;

8.30am	Students to leave St Clement's High School
9.00-9.30am	Schools Arrive/Registration Opens
9.45-11.20am	Session One: Introduction, aims of the day, understanding what it means to be an Anti-Bullying Ambassador
11.20-11.35am	Break
11.35-12.35pm	Session Two: Exploring what bullying behaviour is, how to support your peers
12.35-1.15pm	Lunch
1.15-3.20pm	Session Three: Developing your Anti-Bullying work, campaign planning and next steps
3.20pm-3.30pm	Evaluation
3.30pm	Training day ends – school depart
4.15pm	Return to St Clement's High School

Before the students go to the training event they need to complete a survey to show impact of the session - https://dianaaward.tfaforms.net/f/ABA_Student. We ask that students do this in their own time, but remind them that the library is open for them to use during breaks, lunchtime and after school.

Once the training is completed the students will be supported by the Diana Award and staff members in school in implementing their newly found knowledge, we expect students to meet regularly as a team and have a positive impact on our school community.
