### College of West Anglia Taster Day – Tuesday 24<sup>th</sup> June 2025

On Tuesday 24<sup>th</sup> June 2025, Y10 students have been invited to attend a taster day at the College of West Anglia. The students have already registered for courses that interest them to try for the day. The taster day will give students the opportunity to see if College is an appropriate option for them when applying for Post -16 study.

We strongly advise students to make their own way to the college for the day to completely immerse themselves in the experience or alternatively they can use transport provided by St Clements:

- Students who wish to make their own way to the College of West Anglia should arrive at the refectory on the ground floor of the tower block at King's Lynn campus at 9:30am. The day will finish at 2pm.
- Students who require transport should arrive at school as normal. The coach will leave school at 9am and return before the end of the school day. There is no cost of using this transport.

Students do not need to wear school uniform for the day but clothing must be sensible for a day at college. Students completing Public Protective Services (Uniformed Services) or Sports Taster sessions should arrive ready in (old) P.E. Kit including trainers, shorts and t-shirt. A tracksuit or hoody should be brought along in case of cold weather as well as a drinks bottle.

Students should bring their own pack lunch. If your child is in entitled to free school meals, one will be provided on the day.
