Dear Parents/ Guardians,

Starting high school is an important milestone, and we are proud of how well our Year 7 students have embraced this new chapter. Their enthusiasm and adaptability have been clear to see as they settle into their new routines.

As part of our commitment to providing a well-rounded education, we offer a diverse range of extracurricular activities designed to support your child's development beyond the classroom. These activities provide excellent opportunities for students to explore their interests, build friendships, and gain new skills. Clubs are free of charge and available to all students, there is no need to sign up beforehand. Please see timetable attached overleaf.

We also have a team of visiting music teachers who offer individual or paired lessons for all instruments: String (violin, viola, cello, double bass), Woodwind (flute, oboe, clarinet, bassoon, saxophone), Brass (trumpet, trombone, french horn), Piano, Drum kit, Guitar (and bass guitar), and Singing. We offer a subsidy towards the cost of these lessons, and further help can be offered to Pupil Premium and Free School Meal students. In order to help further, we will loan orchestral instruments free of charge.

For any students who already learn an orchestral instrument (String, Woodwind or Brass) or piano, there is the opportunity to apply for a scholarship. Successful students will receive free weekly individual lessons in years 7 and 8, and half price lessons in year 9.
