Dear Parents/carers,

As we start the new term I wanted to write to you with some concerns we currently have regarding uniform standards in our students. The vast majority of pupils do follow the school rules in relation to uniform. However, as last term progressed increasing numbers of pupils have come to school without their school blazer, a number of piercings as well as with acrylic nails, eyelash extensions and leggings instead of school trousers.

We have shown some leniency with this in recent weeks, however as we enter a new term we do need to insist that all pupils adhere to our uniform rules. From the beginning of this term form tutors, teaching staff and the Senior Leadership team will be having a renewed focus on uniform.

Please can you support us by encouraging your child to return to school with their uniform in line with school policies. Pupils who continue to wear any items not in line with school policy will be issued with a consequence, including detentions, isolation from lessons or being sent home to change/remove items where necessary.

This can easily be avoided by all pupils following our expectations. Thank you for your support in this matter.
