IMPORTANT INFORMATION
Meningococcal ACWY (Men ACWY) and Diphtheria, Tetanus, Polio (DTP)

In line with the National Immunisation Programme, the Community School Aged Immunisation Service offers Meningococcal ACWY and Diphtheria, Tetanus and Polio vaccinations to all pupils in Year 9.

Meningococcal ACWY

Meningococcal ACWY vaccination helps to protect your child against 4 types of meningococcal bacteria (groups A, C, W, and Y) that can cause meningitis (inflammation of the lining of the brain) and septicaemia (blood poisoning). Cases of meningococcal W disease in England have increased significantly in recent years.

Diphtheria, Tetanus and Polio (3 in 1 teenage booster)

This booster dose is important to ensure a young person's continuing immunity and protection against these diseases. University, College increasingly asks for evidence of this vaccination.

Measles / Mumps / Rubella (MMR)

We would also like to remind you that all children and young people should have 2 doses of MMR. If you are not sure whether your child has been fully immunised against MMR, please contact your local CSAIS Team.
