SPONSORED FUN WALK

We are planning to hold a 'Sponsored Fun Walk' on Friday 17th July. This event has been successfully reinstated in our end of year arrangements and will use the same route traditionally walked on a mixture of farm tracks and quiet roads around Terrington St Clement. The full route is just over 8 miles. There will be a shorter walk for those who feel unable to complete the full distance.

We are asking students to make a voluntary donation of £1 on the day via MCAS which can be found in the MCAS store under voluntary donations. We have decided to donate funds raised to Watersafe UK (<https://www.wuksart.org>), they were in school Friday educating Y9's about water safety.

On return to the School, the canteen will be providing a chilli nachos/quorn nachos and a drink as well as the usual range of snacks with students being able to pick and mix from a variety of combinations. If your child is entitled to free school meals one will be provided for them. There will also be ice lollies, cakes and sandwiches etc for sale on the day. It is also our intention to have an ice cream van onsite should students wish to buy an ice cream upon completion of the course.

I do need to stress the need for everyone taking part in the walk to be dressed and equipped appropriately, with the following points taken into consideration:

- Non-School Uniform
- Appropriate footwear – NO flip-flops or flimsy shoes
- Sun protection - a high-factor sun cream and cover for the head and shoulders
- A light raincoat in case of showers (forecast pending)
- Suitable refreshments – NO fizzy drinks, just fruit drinks or water

Students who fail to dress appropriately will not be permitted to participate in the walk and will remain in school instead.

Please can I ask that you contact the school in the event of wishing for your son/daughter to be involved in the shortened walk.
